- snacks are needed for workshops before lunch

- limit 20 participants per group
- have camp counselors assist with discipline
- minimize age gaps among kids (refrain from mixing 6 through 13 year old kids)

- act out scenes (how to handle, what measures would one take)
- what's the best way to approach any kind of conflict (mis-communication)
- talk about people getting drunk to handle conflict
- what happens when don't handle conflict (internalize, go shopping)
- act out conflict and have group comment
- have people come in and act their own conflicts
- people can ask others to play out roles, so others carry through aspects of conflict the original person may not be comfortable with
- 8 out of 8 participants gave thumbs up for the workshops and felt it was important learning

Thursday - July 10, 2008 (Soccer & Tennis)

- get kids out in thinking spot something to do when they are out of the game
- do and process activities about being a looser
