- Organized and held a November 15 crime/public-safety forum attended by Chief Ricucci for the Takoma Park's Philadelphia-Eastern Neighborhood.
- Participated in a November 15 neighborhood walk-around organized by Councilmember Muriel Bowser.
- Discussed community communications including Takoma Metro Station signage with the Old Takoma Business Association.
- Safe Takoma's Board of Directors met on November 16.
- Began organizing a December 13 meeting of the Safe Takoma Advisory Committee to work on program design.
